

KIDS COUNT MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION

As of April 20, 2011 Kids Count, Inc. will administer the following medications as needed---please label with your child's name!

Tylenol/Motrin---preferably generic given to children under 2 only with a doctor's note stating the dosage.

Nystatin- liquid and cream

Neubulizer with meds

Diaper creams; Oragel; Teething tablets

Kids Count will not administer any over the counter drugs.

Prescription medications whether antibiotic or decongestant if needed 3 times a day will be given one time at Kids Count.

If medication is twice/day, it must be given at home!

The "as needed" medication form MUST be completed accurately for meds to be given. Side effects of the drug must be completed--- *NONE is not an appropriate side effect.* If "none" is written meds will not be given.

Infant wing—sheets in classroom and meds to be kept behind locked cabinet doors at all times. Parents do not leave meds in cubby or diaper bag.

Toddler and Preschool---sheets in kitchen and meds are to be kept in a basket in the cabinet. Parents are responsible for bringing meds to kitchen.
